Minutes -

Treasurer -

- Have received both state's athlete fees (\$5 per athlete per state).

- Currently have about \$11,000.

Camping -

 - Will probably have to move to a more central location after the meet.
 - Need to start picking up other electrical panels.

Stalls -

 - Will get 2 bags of shavings for tack and extra stalls.
