1. Minutes –

2. Treasurer Report –

- Received/attached Bank reconciliation Report as of June 4, 2025
- Received/attached Budget/Actuals as of June 4, 2025
- Discussion: Need to get districts to pay to have money in the bank
- If all stays close to budget we will be at about \$13,000 to the good
- Stalls 322; Tack rooms 56 = 378 total
- **Vote: Motion to approve financial; vote; passed**

4. RADIOS –

5. WORK ASSIGNMENTS –

 - Saturday: 100 of 146 filled (46 unfilled; 21 are Jackpot) rest random
 - Sunday: 7 of 33 spots filled (26 unfilled; 16 sorting rest drill)

10. MEDICS

- Scott received an offer from the Medic Company to have an EMT on site for all events at her cost, which is \$32.50 per hour, and ask if they could have an RV spot (or an RV?). Any fill in would be done by the owner if need be. Would be about \$1200 if just used the one. Appears if we stay at or below budget we should end up with enough in stalls and camping to offset this cost.

- VOTE: Unanimously voted to accept offer of \$32.50 per hour and an RV SPOT
